The Builder agreesuse his best efforts to obtaine lowest possible prices from available building material suppliers, but shouldere be an increase time prices of these specified materials that are purchased after dicerconf contract for use in this residential construction project, the Owner agrees to paydoat increase to the builder. Any claim by the Builder for payment of a cost increase, as intend above, shall require ritten notice delivered by the Builder to the Owner stating the increasest, the building material or materials in question, and the source of supply, supposity invoices obills of sale.

SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES – RIGHT OF TERMINATION

Should there be a rise in the cost of any specification material or material, exclusive of any other price changes, that would use the total contract price to increase by more than the Builder shall, before making any additional drases of specified material or materials, provide to the Owner a written statement expired the percentage increase of the contract price, the building material or materials inestion, and the dollar amount the price increase to be incurred. The Owner may then, at his optterminate the contract by providing within business days both written notice of teathirm to the Builder, and payment to the Builder for all costs expended in performance ef contract to the date of termination, plus payment of a prorated percentage of the Beniscoprofits based on the percent of completion. Should both notice of termination and full payment not be forthcoming within _____ business days, as provided herein, the Builder shall httpreeoption to terminate the contract, or to proceed with the contract and purchase the specifieding materials at the increased price. If termination is elected, the Buildshall provide to the Owner a itten notice of termination, and the Owner shall be required to pay the Builderaflohis costs expended in performance of the contract to the date of termination, plus paymeent prorated percentace the Builder's profits based on the percent of completion. If the Buildects to proceed on the contract, he may then purchase the specified material or materials at increased price, and the Owner shall be required to pay the increased cost incurred.
