Policymakers at all levels of government can help by supporting funding for building and construction trades education and providing more placement services to job seekers

In addition to promoting training and jobs in the trades Congress can help by seeking sensible immigration policies that preserve and expand existing temporary work visa programs while also creating new market based visa programs that will accurately match demand with available labor which in turn

- Solves the issue of the millions of undocumented workers already in the U S
- Makes it easier for people to enter the U S to work in the construction industry
